

## **2025-2026** Parent PLUS Loan Special Circumstances Form

The Parent PLUS Loan Special Circumstances form is available for dependent students to request an increase in the Federal Unsubsidized Loan if their parent(s) is *ineligible to apply* for the Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan.

The following circumstances would declare a parent as ineligible:

- Parent(s) is a/are non-U.S. citizen(s) or Permanent Resident(s)
- Parent(s) has/have a bankruptcy/court judgement which prevents further debt
- Parent(s) only form of support is supplemental income (e.g., SSI, disability, etc.)

## A parent's refusal to apply for a Parent PLUS Loan is NOT considered a special circumstance.
