Your cost of attendance is an estimate of your educational expenses for the year. This helps establish your financial need and allows you to calculate how much aid you should apply for to cover your expenses. The cost of attendance includes both billed (e.g. tuition and fees) and non-billed (e.g. transportation) costs. You may also need to budget for additional expenses such as off-campus housing and food. These items are not automatically charged but are factored into your overall cost of attendance.

Billed Costs: Items paid directly to UIW that may include tuition, fees, as well as housing and food for students who choose to live on campus.

Non-Billed Costs: Items not paid directly to UIW that may include transportation, personal expenses and off-campus housing and food.

Financial Aid Checklist

- View your awards and requirements using your GoUIW account. To access GoUIW, visit www.uiw.edu/finaid/financial-aid-details/ofa.html
- Turn in missing documents to Financial Assistance (tax returns, forms, etc.) & Admissions (final transcripts, etc.)
- After you have registered for courses, review your invoice to determine if your aid has covered 100% of your tuition, fees, room & board (if applicable). If not, consider options such as working part-time, enrolling in a payment plan, borrowing loans, veteran education benefits, military discounts, tuition savings plans, etc.
- Search and apply for private scholarships. Find scholarship information from local community/businesses and UIW's Scholarship Resources webpage: www.uiw.edu/finaid/scholarships.
- Submit outside scholarships in person or by mail. Scholarships can be sent to Office of Financial Assistance, 4301 Broadway CPO 308, San Antonio, TX 78209.
- If borrowing federal student loans, complete the required Loan Entrance Counseling and sign your Master Promissory Note (MPN) for a Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loan (MPN) online at studentaid.gov.
- Students interested in working part-time can view work study and student employment opportunities at jobs.uiw.edu.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

- Students must enroll full-time (12+ credit hours per semester) in main campus coursework to receive UIW grants, UIW scholarships, State grants and/or Federal grants (other than Pell). UIW grants and scholarships may be applied towards tuition only.
- Students are required to maintain satisfactory academic progress to use financial aid. Undergraduate students need to complete at least 67% of overall attempted coursework with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- Texas Equalization Grant (TEG) recipients must complete at least 24 credit hours, 75% of attempted course work with a minimum 2.5 GPA each academic year to be considered for renewal.
